

AUTUMN/WINTER FLU & COVID VACCINATION PROGRAMME 2026

It is nearly time for our annual Autumn/Winter vaccination programme. Please can we remind our patients that your GP surgery has bought and allocated these vaccinations for you, if you are eligible and having your jab at your GP surgery helps them!

COVID- Who is eligible?

- adults aged 75 years and over
- residents in care homes for older adults
- individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed, as defined in the COVID-19 chapter of the green book, the UK Health Security Agency's information on immunisation against infectious disease
- Eligibility in autumn 2026 is the same as in the spring 2025, autumn 2025 and spring 2026 campaigns.

FLU - Who is eligible?

- Aged 65 or over (including those who will be 65 by 31 March 2026)
- Aged 18-64 years of age considered at risk (meet eligibility criteria outlined by the NHS)
- Live with someone who is more likely to get a severe infection due to a health condition or weakened immune system
- Pregnant
- Receive a carer's allowance, or are the main carer for an older or disabled person who may be at risk
- Frontline health workers and social care workers who cannot get the vaccine through an occupational health scheme at work

Who is eligible for the COVID VACCINE?

- The government has decided in line with advice from the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI) , that the cohorts eligible for vaccination in England in autumn 2026 are:
- adults aged 75 years and over
- residents in care homes for older adults
- individuals aged 6 months and over who are immunosuppressed, as defined in the COVID-19 chapter of the green book, the UK Health Security Agency's information on immunisation against infectious disease
- Eligibility in autumn 2026 is the same as in the spring 2025, autumn 2025 and spring 2026 campaigns.
